## CLEANING A BAMBOO VISCOSE RUG BAMBOO VISCOSE RUG CARE

1. Vacuum with a nozzle without a brush into the direction in which the fibres are leaning.
2. Bamboo viscose fibres are naturally glossy and smooth, which is why the suction during vacuuming should not be too strong in order not to cause

excessive pulling of the fibres from the nap.

3. A natural feature of viscose rugs is the so-called shedding, i.e. coming out of the viscose fibres from the nap. The shedding process

can be particularly intensified in sheared carpets and in carpets with sheared patterns, where the height of the nap varies.

This is a natural process and can last up to half a year, it is not a basis for complaint.

4. Some of the fibres may come out halfway. Such fibres should be cut with scissors.
5. Viscose fibre reacts badly to water and liquids. Spilled liquids should be drained immediately with a paper towel or cloth that absorbs moisture

well. Then lift the fibres with your fingers, straighten and arrange them in the direction of the other dry fibres of the rug. Not straightened and not arranged properly, viscose fibre will dry out in the previous position. The nap may change its elasticity and reflect light differently in the spot where it was wet/stained after being cleaned with water and dried. Hence, the spot where a stain cleaned with water may differ from the rest of the carpet. This is a natural property of viscose products. Therefore, only professional carpet cleaning is allowed by service providers experienced in cleaning viscose rugs, most often dry cleaning.

6. If wet, dry the rug stretched flat in a well-ventilated room or outdoors when the weather is good.
7. To avoid creasing, periodically move the furniture.
8. Do not use chemicals or bleaches.
9. Exposure of the rug to sunlight may cause its fading. Avoid direct exposure to strong sunlight.

### USEFUL INFORMATION

1. Bamboo viscose is a fibre produced from bamboo cellulose that imitates silk. It is a great alternative to silk products, with similar properties like elegant gloss and velvety softness.
2. Bamboo viscose imitates silk even better than standard viscose. Bamboo viscose rugs are even more glossy and in addition they are cool and velvety soft. They are perfect for hot days as they will cool your feet gently.
3. Bamboo viscose is a much more ecological fabric than regular viscose because of the natural properties of bamboo, such as very fast plant growth with low water use for production. It is also 100% biodegradable.
4. Handmade rugs made of viscose fibre are stretchy. Rugs may change their shape slightly during use. For example, pulling hard on the rug or moving furniture on the rug may change its shape/contour. This change is reversible. Because rugs made of bamboo viscose fibre are naturally stretchy, this is a normal phenomenon and is not a basis for complaint.
5. Rugs from the Handmade collection were handmade, mostly from natural fibres, which is why each of them is original and unique. Therefore, there may be slight differences in their colour, size or design. This is not a basis for complaint.
